GENERAL PLAN UPDATE – SPECIAL WORKSHOP STUDY SESSION

Mayor Campbell opened the meeting to public comment. David Milton spoke of change coming and Fortuna should wait for it. There being no further comments, Councilman Glaser moved and was seconded by Councilman Whitchurch to close the public comment portion of the meeting.

City Manager Rigge reviewed the schedule including the Circulation, Public Hearings and Certification of the Program Environmental Impact Report (PEIR) and the adoption of the General Plan.

Mayor Pro Tem Whitchurch commented on the dates set aside for the final Public Hearing and adoption of the General Plan, stating he would be on vacation during that time. Staff was advised that the dates should be revised to ensure the entire council would be in attendance.

Oral staff report and review of the General Plan Policy Document was pulled from the Agenda and postponed to a later date.

Consultant George Williamson gave an oral report providing an overview of the General Plan Update Program Environmental Impact Report including the topics of the various chapters and the scope of the document

Mayor Campbell opened the meeting to public comment. David Milton commented on the Hospital not being included in Chapter 2 of the PIER. Consultant George Williamson said the hospital does not affect the Environmental Analysis. Sue Long asked for the date the Policy Document would be available. Frank Stover from the Humboldt Beacon asked for an explanation of PM¹⁰ which are airborne particulates.

It was agreed by council that there was not a need for a second meeting on October 30, 2007. There being no further comment Councilman Whitchurch moved, and was seconded by Councilman Berti, to close public comment. The meeting adjourned at 6:59 PM. No action was taken.
